This is the first workshop of a series of 4 workshops for the spring of 2024. Each month, we present one workshop on a different topic. The prevalence and availability of the Board for Evaluation of Interpreter (BEI) certifications continues to grow and this workshop will provide an overview of the components of the BEI Test of English Proficiency (TEP) and performance exams. We will also explore the eligibility criteria unique to Texas, Illinois, Michigan, Missouri, and Wisconsin. At the end of this workshop, you will be able to articulate the components of the BEI Certification test. Also, you will be able to examine the pathway to certification in a state that offers the BEI certification test.
