- **Sign Interpreter Skills Evaluation (SLI-SE):** This evaluation is designed to provide both individual interpreters and prospective employers with a basic yet realistic assessment of an interpreter's skill set. Interpreters who have not taken a certification test or have yet to pass, can determine if they are ready to test or if there has been enough improvement to warrant testing again. Evaluation results will be sent via email and will indicate at which skill level our evaluators consider the interpreter to be performing at.
